

EVENTS, WORKSHOPS AND SEMINARS

1.An Inter-house quiz competition for grade XII was held in April 2024 in the school amphitheatre. This event aimed to foster a spirit of healthy competition among the school houses, enhance the students' general knowledge on 'Lok Sabha Elections' and encourage teamwork. The competition was well attended by students, teachers and representatives from all the four houses.

2.A talent show, held in April 2024 in the school amphitheatre, showcased the diverse talents of students from grade X. The event provided a platform for students to display their artistic, musical and creative abilities. The talent show featured performances across various categories including music, dance etc. The success of the event suggested that such talent show should continue to be a staple of the school calendar with even more opportunities for students to shine in future edition.

3. Bag less days' is an initiative by CBSE, adopted by our school in order to promote a healthy, more engaging, and less stressful school environment. The approach encourages students to spend two days a week without heavy bags focusing more on recreational activities.

4.From April 2024 till August 2024, the school organized a variety of activities and workshops which aimed at enhancing students' overall development beyond the classroom. Clay modelling and flag making workshops were for grades VI and VII respectively. On 31st July 2024, two students from grade XI and a teacher attended a workshop on 'Photography as a career' organized by HT Media Pvt Ltd. Around 320 students went to watch a movie 'Inside Out' as a part of HT educational program. 'Best out of waste' exhibition was put up by students of grade XI to promote environmental awareness and creativity among students to encourage students to think creatively about recycling and upcycling items, turning waste into useful and aesthetically pleasing items. The school upholds its promise to offer a wide array of co-curricular activities to ensure the continued growth and development of students.

5.The 78th Independence Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm and patriotic fervour. The event commemorated India's freedom and honored the sacrifices of the freedom fighters. The school campus was adorned with tricolors and the atmosphere was charged with the sense of pride and natural unity as students, teachers and staff came together to celebrate the day. The day was dolled up more with the presence of our honorable chief guest .The independence day celebration was followed by the 'Investiture ceremony', a memorable and inspiring event that successfully instilled the values of leadership and responsibility in the newly appointed student council members. The head boy, Ansh Saini and the head girl, Yuvika Arora, along with other council members reflected the school's commitment to develop well rounded students who are prepared to take leadership roles both within and beyond the school.

6. The eco club of the school has been actively involved in promoting environmental awareness and sustainability. The club initiatives aim to educate students about environmental issues and encourage ecofriendly practices and foster a sense of responsibility towards protecting the environment. The key activities, organised by the eco club from April 2024 to August 2024, include class presentation, poster making on 'Say no to plastic' and 'Global Warming', Nukkad Natak ,PDF on environmental concerns shared with staff and students, display boards, campaigns etc.

7.To provide clarity, direction and structured approach to career planning, a career counselling session for the commerce students of grade XII was held on 3rd August 2024. It was conducted by ACCA Mr Yash Gupta, and CA Ms Manvi Gupta, both proud alumni of our school.

8.A workshop on role play was held on 3rd August 2024. Under the supervision and abled guidance of our respected Manoj sir, the event resonated volumes about the real time situations faced by teachers and students. It suggested the probable solutions anticipated to be adopted by the stakeholders.

9.A workshop on menstrual hygiene / personal hygiene was conducted in July 2024 for boys and girls separately. The event aimed to educate participants about the importance of menstrual hygiene, break the stigmas surrounding menstruation and provide practical knowledge on managing menstrual health. The workshop was attended by students of grades VI, VII and VIII. The expert, Ms Ankita sukhwan from global hunt ,conducted and concluded the informative session on 'biological processes of menstruation'.

10. On 26 July 2024, students of grades VIII and IX visited Vikas publishing house, a renowned publication House in Sahibabad, Uttar Pradesh. The purpose of the visit was to provide students with an insight into the various processes involved in the publishing industry, from manuscript acquisition to the distribution of printed books. The curriculum helped the students in understanding the practical aspects of publishing. The teachers accompanied student were Ms. Komal Choudhary, Ms. Deepika Naudiyal and Mr. Hariom Sharma.

11. An in person t-Gelf workshop was organized by Ms Dinu Raheja on 30th April 2024 at t-Gelf office, Gurugram. The session emphasized on the formation of student companies and financial literacy among the children. The workshop was attended by Ms Komal Choudhary, PGT commerce, Dev Samaj Modern School, Nehru Nagar.
